NOTICE OF VACANCY Paralegal (PT)

Date of Issue: 04/30/21. The work involves performing paralegal duties in a county department or other local municipal office. The incumbent works under the supervision of attorneys who assign work projects by setting overall objectives and deadlines. This position is responsible for performing a variety of tasks, that while not requiring the skills of an attorney, nevertheless, entail the application of legal procedures and research techniques to facilitate the preparation and checking of legal documents and matters of litigation. Depending upon the department or municipality involved, the incumbent's specific duties may vary within the broad framework of paralegal skills. Supervision may be exercised over appropriate office personnel to establish priorities and assign and review completed work. Does related work as required.

The title of Paralegal (PT) is **Non-Competitive**, requiring applicants to meet minimum qualifications established for the position. Pending a criminal background check*, appointment may be made to this position.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS: Graduation from high school or possession of a high school equivalency diploma and **EITHER:**

- b. Two (2) years of full-time experience or its part-time equivalent as a Paralegal; **OR**
- c. Four (4) years of full-time experience or its part-time equivalent as a Legal Assistant; **OR**
- d. Any combination of training and experience as defined by the limits of (a), (b), and (c).
